For nearly 2,000 years the Shang Han Lun has been the cornerstone of applied Chinese medicine. In its pages classical texts like the Huang Di Nei Jing and the Shen Nong Ben Cao Jing are brought together in Chinese medicine’s greatest practical clinical manual, a book whose treatment strategies are as sound and effective today as they were in the Han dynasty.

In this course, students will learn the Six Conformations diagnostic model (also known as Six Channel Theory). This model allows the practitioner to diagnose diseases systemically by accurately forecasting the passage of disease through both time and location, and clearly seeing the connections between the organs, channels, and symptoms.

The Classical Herbology series is designed to not only teach a student how the body works through the eyes of Classical Chinese Medicine, but also why it works that way and how disease symptoms are developed from a pathological process. Rather than rote memorization, students are encouraged to study the thought processes of the ancient architects of the medicine by deconstructing herbal formulas and applying learned diagnostic principles via sample case studies. Above all, students will learn to use the Shang Han Lun as a clinical handbook and a blueprint for treating all diseases.
