this is not a standard job in an acupuncture practice- a special person is needed, not only because the transition into a trusted partner and eventual owner would be a slow and perhaps arduous one, but there is some resistance from the lead acupuncturist at this point. a new graduate is possible but this person would need to be highly skilled and perhaps trained prior to graduating. an intern situation is probably not going to work- although in some ways this would be idea as income would not be consistent high much to begin with -0 there is a high learning curve and work would increase over time. we do a lot of insurance work so licensure would be good and getting on insurance panels would be required.
