CARES Act Emergency Aid Grant Notice (January 8, 2021)

Dear Students,

In an effort to provide much needed assistance to those impacted by COVID-19, the Florida College of Integrative Medicine ("we" or "FCIM") has applied to the U.S. Department of Education ("Department") for grant funding pursuant to the CARES Act. Please be hereby notified of the following:

- 1. FCIM has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that FCIM has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement equal \$58,486, of which no less than 50 percent (\$29,243) has been used as Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 3. Based on results received by FCIM's online CARES Act grant application portal as of September 30, 2020, a total of 28 of FCIM's then-enrolled students, by virtue of their eligibility to participate in the Federal Student Financial Aid programs under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (as amended), were eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
- 4. The grant funds have been distributed to eligible recipients as of October 31, 2020.
- 5. Each recipient received \$1,200.00 of CARES Act grant funds. To date, of the \$58,486 in CARES Act grant funds received by FCIM, a total of \$33,600 has been distributed to eligible recipients as student grants.
