CRRSAA (HEERF II) Emergency Financial Aid Grant Notice (January 4, 2022)

FCIM has signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that FCIM has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA program to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

The total amount of funds that FCIM will receive from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA program is \$52,532.00. Of this amount, FCIM has, to date, received a total of \$52,532.00.

As of the date of this notice, FCIM has distributed all of the above-referenced \$52,532.00 to eligible students. The distribution was conducted in two (2) phases, where Phase 1 equal to 50% of the total award (or \$26,266) was distributed to eligible students on or prior to June 30, 2021 and Phase 2 equal to 50% of the total award (or \$26,266) was distributed to eligible students on or prior to November 30, 2021.

For Phase 1 distribution, based on information submitted through the online application process that was completed as of June 14, 2021, a total of 30 FCIM students were deemed eligible to receive aid under the CRRSAA program. The amount of Phase 1 grant distributable to any given eligible student is determined by such student's demonstrated level of need, which may be "Level 1", "Level 2" or "Level 3". Each student with "Level 1" need received \$596.95. Each student with "Level 2" need received \$1,193.91. Each student with "Level 3" need received \$1,790.86.

For Phase 2 distribution, based on information submitted through the online application process that was completed as of October 29, 2021, a total of 35 FCIM students were deemed eligible to receive aid under the CRRSAA program. The amount of Phase 2 grant distributable to any given eligible student is determined by such student's demonstrated level of need, where the minimum award was \$198.98 and the maximum award was \$1,193.91.
